



International Green Hydrogen Alliance (IGH2A)

This Membership Charter accommodates two types of memberships within the International Green Hydrogen Alliance, providing a comprehensive framework for both country and the specified second type of members.

Country Membership Charter

Article 1: Country Membership Criteria

1.1 Eligibility:

Specified Membership Charter
